APPENDIX 3B AND CLEANSING NOTICE – SHARE PLACEMENT

Please find attached an Appendix 3B in respect of the issue of 11,458,140 ordinary fully paid shares to unrelated professional and sophisticated investors pursuant to the share placement ("Placement") announced to ASX on 3 October 2019.

The first tranche of the Placement was completed pursuant to the Company's security issue capacities under Listing Rule 7.1 and 7.1A. A total of 4,215,251 Shares was issued pursuant to Listing Rule 7.1 and 7,242,889 Shares issued pursuant to Listing Rule 7.1A.

The balance of the shares to be issued pursuant to the Placement requires shareholder approval for the directors of the Company to subscribe for 169,767 shares on the same terms. The Company will seek approval for the placement to directors and their related parties at the Annual General Meeting planned for 27 November 2019. A notice for the Annual General Meeting will be provided to shareholders in due course.

A cleansing notice in respect of the share issue is attached.

The Company did not consider that a pro rata entitlement issue or a share purchase plan would raise the \$5 million in the timeframe or at the issue price achieved by the Placement.

No underwriting arrangements or underwriting fees payable were incurred in connection with the Placement.

Commission fees totalling \$295,620 are payable to third parties in relation to the issue.
